[Imperfect] Lives with Perfect Peace

This month, we will celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus. This holy day celebrates the greatest miracle of all! But, before we get to Resurrection Sunday on April 17, we will practice remembering Christ's experiences of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. These three holy days of the Christian calendar are good teachers about our "imperfect lives" and the love of Christ that perseveres and offers us perfect peace.



Palm Sunday - Imperfect people, like you and I, welcome and cheer Jesus' arrival to Jerusalem as a King. They were expecting Him to conquer Romans, and the peace they thought He'd bring was far less than the perfect peace He knew we needed.

Maundy Thursday - is a night where Jesus talks about our call to serve and love one another. He shares the Passover meal with His Disciples, and yet one of them has already begun to betray Him. Jesus washes His Disciples' feet.

Good Friday - it's strange to many to call this day good. This day, we remember that our perfect Lord Jesus gave Himself willingly to a suffering death that worked to cover over our imperfections and restore us to relationship with God.

These three days remind us that we humans are imperfect, but they also remind us that Our Lord Jesus Christ persevered in His deep love for us.

The “perfect peace” that is mentioned in Isaiah 26:3 is available from Jesus Christ. In this world we will have troubles, but take heart - Jesus Christ, through His perfect life, sacrificial death, and victorious resurrection has overcome the imperfections of the world (John 16:33).

The perfect love of God is not conquered by the evil, sin, and darkness of this world. No! The love and light of God is far greater. Jesus Christ offers us full lives of peace with God - for now and eternity. Keep your minds on Jesus Christ! He is our rock eternal!

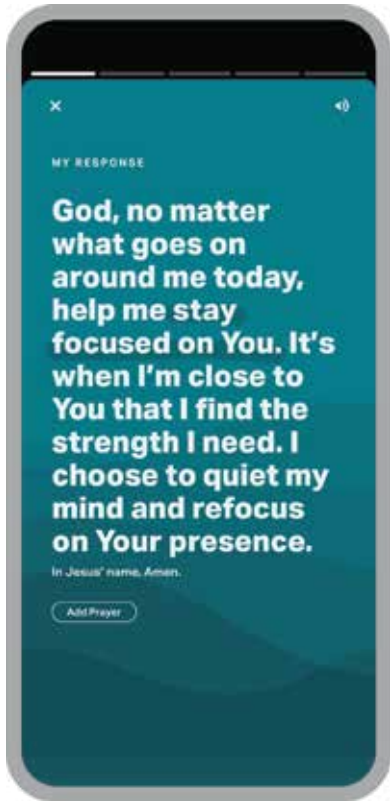
